

COUNTRY & CHIC



Origin is our BIO yarn, proposed in a garment realized with circular needles and with jacquard manufacture on yoke. The technique is that of the old days hand-knitted sweaters but with a definitely modern result!




Yarn: ORIGIN col. 1494 beige, col. 1776 dark pink, col. 3339 petroleum.

Needles: circular needle n. 3 and n. 3.5.

Crochet Hook: n. 3

Weight: 470 g/16.50 oz (9 balls of col. beige, 1 ball of col. dark pink, 1 ball of col. petroleum).

Stitches used: 2x2 Rib, Operated Stitch (in round), embroidery in Chain Stitch, Jacquard Knit.



Explanation of Operated Stitch (in round):

1st - 2nd - 3rd round: knit

4th round: knit 3, purl 1

5th - 6th - 7th round: knit

8th round: knit, purl 1 (knit 3, purl 1), knit 3

9th round: repeat from 1st round

Gauge in operated stitch:

12 cm (4.75 in) = 21 stitches

Size 40: for each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0.75 in) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0.75 in) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 5 rounds.

Knitting the back and the front

Using a circular needle n. 3 and col. beige, cast on 152 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib** for 15 rounds, then using circular needle n. 3.5 work in **Operated Stitch**, increasing 16 stitches on the first round, distributing the stitches on all the length of the round. Work in **Operated Stitch** for 103 rounds (38 cm = 15 in), then leave all the stitches suspended.

Knitting the sleeves

Using a circular needle n. 3 and col. beige, cast on 42 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib** for 15 rounds, then using a circular needle n. 3.5 work in **Operated Stitch**, increasing internally on the first and the last stitch of the round, 1 stitch every 2 rounds 16 times. You will end up with 76 stitches, suspend work at the total height of 44 cm (17.32 in). Make the other sleeve as the first one.

Knitting the yoke

Join all the parts on one needle as follows: 76 stitches of the right sleeve, 84 stitches of the front, 76 stitches of the left sleeve, 84 stitches of the back, casting on new stitch at the joint of each part (320 stitches

+ 4 = 324 total stitches). Work in **Operated Stitch** in col. beige. At the total height of 40 cm (15.75 in) (measured in the front or the back), start working the **Jacquard** pattern, with the yarn in col. beige and col. dark pink. Simultaneously, for the raglan, decrease every 2 rows 1 stitch for side at the sleeves, in the front and in the back, internally 2 stitches. Work the design pattern until completed. On the front and on the back there are: 19 stitches in **Operated Stitch** in col. beige, 47 stitches in **Jacquard knit** (2 designs), 19 stitches in **Operated Stitch** in col. beige. On the sleeves there are: 23 stitches in **Operated Stitch** in col. beige, 31 stitches in **Jacquard knit** (2 designs), 23 stitches in **Operated Stitch** in col. beige. Once completed the design pattern, you will remain with 100 stitches on the needle, that will be used for the neck. Work in **2x2 Rib** with col. beige for 6 rounds, bind off.

Finishing

Using col. pink, embroider between the design in front and the back, in a way to create a continuous design (see photo). Then, using col. petroleum, add embroidered dots, in the high part of yoke, close to the neck, and on the raglan. Finally, always with col. petroleum, make bobble using crochet hook, casting on 5 chains of 4 stitches each, starting out all from the same point. Make 4 bobbles in the front, 4 in the back, 3 for each sleeve.
