

REGENT STREET



Our Arboris is a yarn with a delicate rustic look, made with pure virgin wool and natural linen. We used it to create Regent Street, a garment with a masculine, sporty and comfortable look, reached by knitting together different stitches in a game of delicate lines.



Yarn: ARBORIS col. 3760 petroleum


Needles: n. 5,5

Circular needle: n. 5,5

Weight: 520 g/18,34 oz (11 balls).

Size: 50

Stitches used: 2x2 Rib, Stockinette Stitch, Tubular, Garter Stitch, Operated Stitch.



Explanation of operated stitch:

Work 4 rows in reverse stockinette stitch and 2 rows in stockinette stitch.

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 in. x 4 in.): 14 stitches and 18 rows

Size 50: for each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0.75 in) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 3 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0.75 in.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 rows.

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Knitting the back

Using n. 5,5 needles and contrast color yarn, cast on 86 stitches and knit one row (at the end of the work this row will be undone).

Using Arboris col. 3760 petroleum, purl one row and work in **Tubular** for 4 rows, then continue in **2x2 Rib** for 8 cm (3.25 in.). Work in **Stockinette Stitch** for 18 cm (7 in.), then in **Garter Stitch** for 18 cm (7 in.). At the total height of 44 cm (17.25 in.), work in **Operated Stitch**. Simultaneously, at the total height of 47 cm (18.5 in.), to shape the armholes, bind off at the sides 2 stitches and continue decreasing 1 stitch every 2 rows 4 times. At the 72 cm (28.25 in.) of total height, for the shoulders, bind off remaining 18 stitches for side in 3 times, so 6 stitches at the time.

Knitting the front

Using n. 5,5 needles and contrast color yarn, cast on 86 stitches and knit one row (at the end of work this row will be undone).

Using Arboris col. 3760 petroleum, purl one row and work in **Tubular** for 4 rows, then continue in **2x2 Rib** for 8 cm (3.25 in.). Work in **Stockinette Stitch** for 18 cm (7 in.), then in **Garter Stitch** for 18 cm (7 in.). At the total height of 44 cm (17.25 in.), work in **Operated Stitch**. Simultaneously, at the total height of 47 cm (18.5 in.), to shape the armholes, bind off at the sides 2 stitches and continue decreasing 1 stitch every 2 rows 4 times. At the 65 cm (25.5 in.) of total height, for the neckline, bind off 18 central stitches and continue two parts separately, decreasing at the side of the neckline 3 stitches every 2 rows once, 2 stitches every 2 rows 3 times. At the total height of 72 cm (28.5 in.), for the shoulders, bind off remaining 18 stitches for side in 3 times, so 6 stitches at the time.

Knitting the sleeves

Using n. 5,5 needles and contrast color yarn, cast on 52 stitches and knit one row (at the end of work this row will be undone). Using Arboris col. 3760 petroleum, purl one row and work in **Tubular** for 4 rows, then continue in **2x2 Rib** for 8 cm (3.25 in.). Work, increasing 1 stitch for side every 10 rows 7 times, in **Stockinette Stitch** for 20 cm (8 in.), then work in **Operated Stitch** for 10 cm (4 in.). At the total height of 38 cm (15 in.), work in **Stockinette Stitch**. Simultaneously, to shape the sleeve, bind off at sides 2 stitches and continue decreasing 1 stitch every 2 rows. At the 56 cm (22 in.) of total height, bind off remaining stitches. Make the second sleeve as the first one.

FINISHING

Sew the shoulder seams, sew up the side and sleeve seams, and sew in the sleeves. For the neck, using the circular needle n. 5,5, pick up stitches of the neckline in front and of the neckline in the back, work in **2x2 Rib** for 22 cm (8.75 in.), then work in **Tubular** for 2 rows and bind off in Tubular with a needle.
