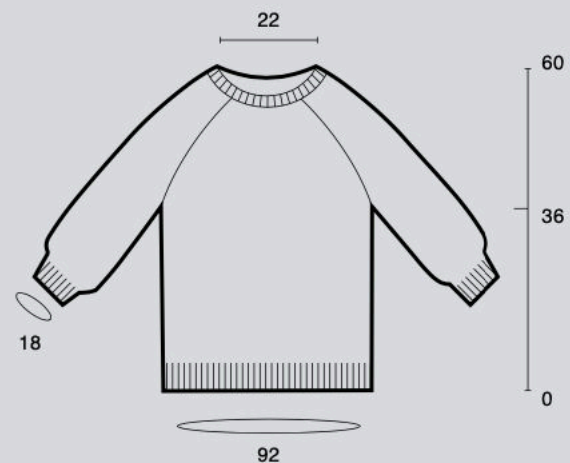
Yarn: ECHOS PRINT col. 4479.

Circular Needles: n. 9 (length 60 cm and 20 cm = 23,62 in. and 7,87 in.)

Weight: 530 g/18,86 in. (11 balls)

Size 42

Stitches used: 2x2 Rib, Operated Stitch (Stockinette Stitch, Garter Stitch, Moss Stitch)



Explanation of Operated Stitch

(in round): This pattern is a set of stitches that are repeated in sequence.

Make:

4 rounds in Moss Stitch

2 rounds in Garter Stitch

4 rounds in Moss Stitch

2 rounds in Garter Stitch

4 rounds in Stockinette Stitch

2 rounds in Garter Stitch

Repeat always this sequence

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 inc. x 4 inc.) = 11 stitches and 17 rounds.

Size 42: for each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0.75 inc.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 2 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0.75 inc.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 rounds.

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Knitting front and back

Using n. 9 circular needle (length 60 cm/ 15,75 in.) cast on 96 stitches and join in round, work in **2x2 Rib** for 6 rounds, then start working in **Operated Stitch**, decreasing 3 stitches while making the first round. At a total height of 36 cm (14,17 in.), on the second round of **Stockinette Stitch**, suspend work to which you will join the sleeves.

Knitting the sleeves

Using n. 9 circular needles (length 20 cm/7,87 in.) cast on 24 stitches and join in round, work in **2x2 Rib** for 10 rounds, then start working in **Operated Stitch**, increasing 5 stitches while making the first round. At a total height of 8 cm (3,15 in.), increase 2 stitches every 12 rounds twice, 2 stitches every 4 rounds twice, 2 stitches every 2 rounds once. At a total height of 38 cm (14,96 in.), on the second round of **Stockinette Stitch**, suspend work. Make the other sleeve as the first one.

Yoke

Join sleeves to front and back making round of union in **Stockinette Stitch**: work 46 stitches, then cast on 2

new stitches and join the sleeve onto needle, cast on 2 new stitches and continue joining other 47 stitches, then cast on 2 new stitches, join the other sleeve, cast on 2 new stitches and rejoin into the round.

Work in **Operated Stitch** always knitting 2 on the new stitches (they will form a raglan). On the round after union, decrease 1 stitch on front side and back side. From the next round, decrease 1 stitch every 2 rounds right before and after knit stitches of the raglan (increased at joining round). Continue in the same way, always decreasing at the raglan, until you have 47 stitches in total.

Then work in **2x2 Rib**, increasing 1 stitch on a first round. Make 4 rounds in **2x2 Rib**, then bind off.

Finishing:

Garment is already finished. Wave in and block any loose ends, join the sleeve seams.
